

Installation:


Check that SODE 1.6.2 is installed and running. You can download SODE from here:

https://sode.12bpilot.ch/?page_id=9

Don't forget to make sure after installing SODE that the modules are **registered and activated!**

SODE 1.6.3 Open-Beta will not be supported!

1.) Copy the directory "SODE_Jetways for Malpensa Pro-P3Dv4" to the scenery add-on directory (depending on where you installed it)



2.) Start the SODE-ON.BAT batch job file (double click), to activate the SODE Jetways in the scenery

If you want back the CTRL-J Jetways or before you install an update for the scenery, double click the SODE-OFF.BAT to revert into the normal scenery state.

License:

The use of the SODE jetways is free For Milan Malpensa P3dv4 Scenery add-on only! Please recognize that we do not provide any troubleshooting support for SODE or this SODE jetways and do not guarantee the function in future versions of Prepar3d in combination with SODE since these are third party programs.

The Milan Malpensa scenery are delivered with custom made high definition animated jetways following the SDK techniques (CTRL-J) which are part of the "main product". Nevertheless some users prefer to use SODE jetways instead.

You can go back to CTRL-J jetways at any time using the SODE-OFF.BAT.
